

# BATTING HONORS OF HICKEY LOOP GIVEN C. HIGH IN OFFICIAL FIGURES.

Fenner, Who Had Higher Average Than Minneapolis Veteran, Not in Enough Games to Justify Preference; Cullop Led in Runs, Total Bases and Homers

**G**HITTING his way through stiff competition during the entire season, Charley High, veteran All-American slugger, emerged the leader in a close race for the 1930 batting championship of the American Association, the final official avg. giving him a percentage of .382. High, who is a brother of Andy High, until recently an infielder with the St. Louis Cardinals, was closely pressed by a youngster and a veteran in the dash for the batting crown. Bob Fenton, the young right fielder, catcher, finished with an average of .391, tops in the year by nine points, but as Fenton played in only 101 games with the Minneapolis outfielder appeared in 104 contests, the determining leaders being generally considered to have been the 100-game contestants—the honors for the year were given to High. DeWitt LeBaron of Toledo, a seasoned batter, was just behind High with an average of .330 in 134 games. Nick Cullop, another Minneapolis veteran, who was sold to the Cincinnati Reds late in the season, grabbed the lion's share of the honors, leading the league in runs scored with 150, in total bases with 392, in runs batted in with 163 and in home runs with 64. Cullop's home total established a new American Association record, eclipsing the former high mark of 42, set by Jimmy Butler of Kansas City in 1922. Butch Simmons, leading hitter of the champion Detroit Indians, set the pace in hits and doubles, 245 and 100 respectively. Honus Layne, also of Louisville, led in triples with 10 and placed him next to the other base runners by stealing 49 sacks.

Every team in the loop, excepting the St. Paul and Minneapolis糟粕, were close records with .312. The pennant-winning Colonels finished fourth with .306. Indianapolis, although batting .306 as a team, brought up the rear in stickwork.
